By logging filter checks on a calendar—marking the date you inspected and replaced—you prevent the most common reason units fail prematurely. Beyond filters, your quarterly checklist should include a visual inspection of the outdoor condenser unit for debris, checking that nothing is blocking airflow, and making sure the area around the unit stays clear of vegetation (2 feet minimum clearance is essential). During Sacramento's hot dry summers when temperatures exceed 100°F, condenser coils collect dust and pollen rapidly, so monthly coil inspection becomes part of your documented workflow.
