- T1-eleven or rough sawn plywood with deep grooves that accumulate dust and chalk

- Cinder block, stucco, or brick on older detached garages

Blue tape helps me mark all punch gadgets so nothing is missed.

Look for these patterns:

- Chalking and UV burn on south and west faces. If your hand comes away white after a rub, you want a rinse with a gentle detergent and, in some instances, an acrylic bonding primer.
- Rust bleed on metal fasteners and hinges. That needs a rust converter or a right away to metallic primer, not just extra paint.
- Oil and silicone around storage door tracks and weatherstripping. Solvent cleansing, then a rinse, prevents fish eyes.
- Hairline cracks the place T1-11 grooves meet horizontal trim. Water drives in there. A excessive elasticity sealant with a acceptable backer bead assists in keeping the joint from tearing.
- Efflorescence on block partitions. That white bloom will push paint off unless the salts are scrubbed away and the wall can dry.

On T1-11, I want a penetrating alkyd primer on weathered timber, then a complete acrylic topcoat. For new OSB or plywood from a shed package, stay up for mill glaze and prime resin. A scuff sand, a radical blank, and a exceptional bonding primer discontinue early peeling.

On metallic garage doors, the substrate will be factory baked tooth or powder coat. Both are slick. Scuff pads aid, however the key is a distinctiveness bonding primer made for tough, shiny surfaces. If the block is dry, get rid of efflorescence with a stiff brush and water, top with a masonry primer, then conclude with a breathable acrylic. I preclude heavy elastomerics on small garages until cracks are energetic and require bridging, on account that these coatings can catch moisture in thin partitions.

Two timing tips depend and get missed through DIYers. First, wood moisture. Shoot for underneath 15 percent in the past priming. Second, temperature and dew aspect. Paint in the producer's window, sometimes 50 to 90 tiers

Fahrenheit, and hinder an eye on evening dew. That incredibly satin sheen can flash flat if moisture hits uncured paint.

Picking the perfect coatings by surface

- Masonry: Acrylic masonry coatings with nice vapor permeability. If lively cracks exist, a patching compound or an elastomeric in prefer zones can help. Do now not wrap the complete construction in a thick rubbery film until moisture conditions are beneath regulate.
