A traditional 1v1 game of chance. Two gamers wager skins of approximately equal value. The system designates one gamer as Heads and the other as Tails, then turns a virtual coin. The winner takes the whole pot, minus a little platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match wagering is the go-to alternative. Users bet on professional teams using odds calculated by the platform, comparable to traditional sportsbooks.
