Verified gambling platforms require an onboarding process that includes identity checks. This is not just bureaucracy—it's a safety feature aimed at:

- **Protecting Minors:** Ensuring all users are of legal gambling age.
- **Preventing Fraud:** Confirming personal details reduces identity theft or fake accounts.
- **Enabling Secure Payments:** Matching identity to bank accounts or wallets ensures safe withdrawal and deposit processes.
- **Following Legal Requirements:** Complying with PAGCOR's KYC (Know Your Customer) regulations helps prevent money laundering and protects players.

If a Casino Plus link directs you to a site that skips onboarding or asks suspicious personal data without explaining why, do not proceed. Legitimate operators will have clear onboarding steps with security reassurances.
