

Moving across state lines involves more than transporting belongings, since utilities, mail, and official records all need updating during the transition. Scheduling Utility Transfers Before a DMV Moving Company Arrives

Contacting electric, gas, water, and [DMV movers](#) internet providers at least two to three weeks before the move helps ensure utilities are active at the new home on arrival day. A DMV moving company recommends scheduling utility shutoff at the old address for the day after moving out, providing a buffer in case of any final tasks.

Address Transfer Steps Recommended by DMV Movers

DMV movers suggest updating a mailing address with the postal service at least two weeks before the move, along with notifying banks, insurance providers, and subscription services of the new address. Updating a driver's license and vehicle registration in the new state typically needs to happen within a specific window after establishing residency.

- Contact utility providers two to three weeks before the move
- Schedule utility shutoff for the day after moving out
- Update mailing address with the postal service in advance
- Notify banks, insurance providers, and subscription services
- Update driver's license and vehicle registration in the new state

Timing Considerations for Movers in DMV Crossing State Lines

Building in some flexibility between utility activation and the moving date helps avoid this situation.
