

When Is the Best Time for Garage Door Repair in Tarzana?

Common Summer and Winter Problems

Summer's **extreme heat** can make some problems more noticeable. A door may become louder as lubrication wears away, or a worn seal may harden and split. Metal components and panels can experience **door expansion**, which may result in friction or temporary alignment issues. Direct sunlight can also warm the garage interior, influencing batteries, remotes, and some opener electronics.

Lubrication should be completed with products approved for garage doors rather than ordinary household oils. Too much lubricant can attract dust and cause buildup, so a technician should determine which hinges, rollers, bearings, or springs need service.

Winter problems are usually caused by **storm-related damage**, moisture, wind, or overlooked wear.
