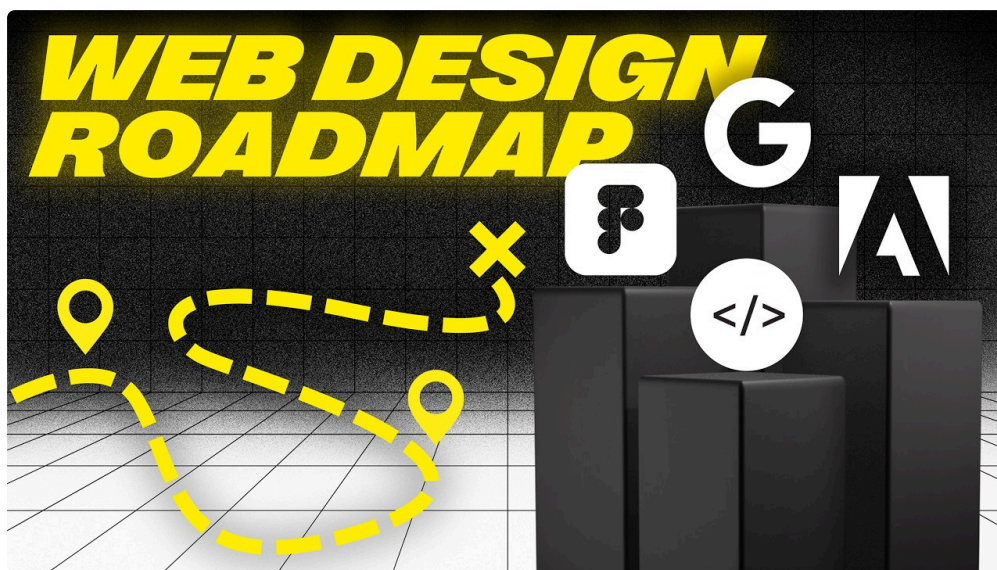
1. Process confidential data lawfully, particularly, and transparently.
