

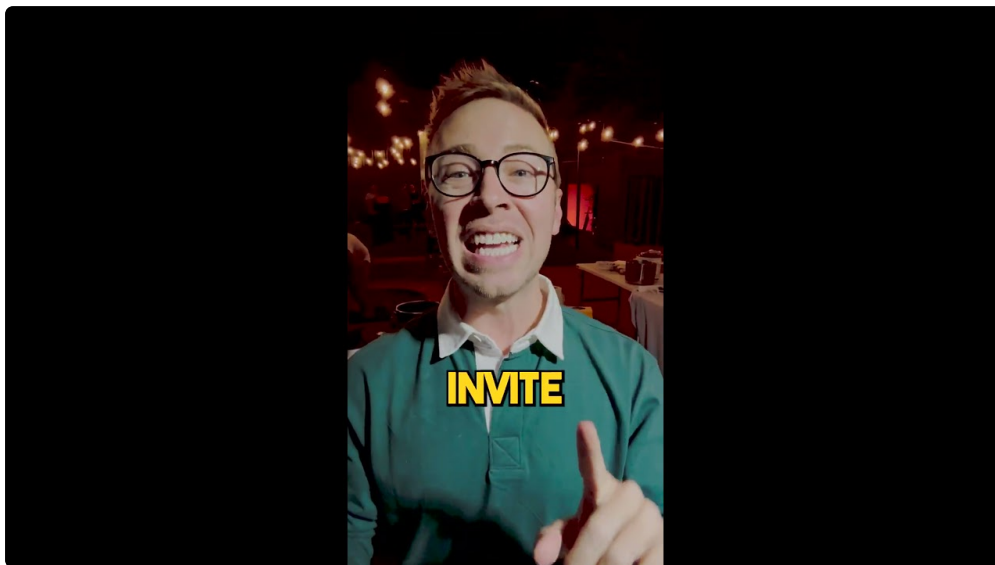
The Unique Challenge of Twin and Close-Sibling Birthdays
