A quick caution from a task on a 1940s bungalow: the property owner rented a three,000 PSI computing device and carved tiger stripes into her cedar clapboards. The strains showed due to even after two coats. Lower power with wider recommendations could have saved her a full day of hand sanding.

Timing, weather, and moisture count greater than maximum employees think
