- **Third-Party Trading Sites:** Platforms such as CSGOSkins.gg, Skinbay, or Buff.163 frequently list cases at slightly lower commissions, but verify seller track record.
- **Community Giveaways & Events:** Occasionally, Valve or neighborhood influencers host free gifts where older cases are awarded. Participating in official CS: GO competitions can likewise yield legacy case drops.
- **Package Purchase:** Some collectors buy "secret boxes" that may include older cases; nevertheless, this approach is risky and typically not cost-effective.
