Comprehending the Top Slot

Before the main wheel is spun in each round, a separate two-reel slots positioned above the main wheel-- referred to as the **Top Slot**-- spins at the same time.

- **Reel 1** screens one of the betting segments (numbers or reward video games).
- **Reel 2** displays a multiplier value (ranging from 2x approximately 50x).

If the arbitrarily generated combination on the Top Slot lines up on the horizontal payline, the multiplier is used to that specific segment for the upcoming spin. If the wheel arrive at a number sector improved by the Top Slot, the payout for that number is increased accordingly. If the Top Slot couple with a reward game, all multipliers within that reward round are multiplied by the designated worth.

The Four Immersive Bonus Rounds

1. Coin Flip

The Coin Flip is the most frequently taking place perk game.

- **The Mechanic:** The host turns a coin that has a red side and a blue side. Each side is designated a random multiplier produced before the flip.
- **The Outcome:** Whichever side faces upward when the coin lands determines the winning multiplier for all gamers who wager on the Coin Flip segment.

2. Money Hunt

Money Hunt looks like a conventional shooting gallery video game presented on a huge digital wall.



- **The Mechanic:** The screen displays a grid consisting of 108 random multipliers, which are then covered by numerous signs (such as a cactus, target, or chef hat) and shuffled.
- **The Outcome:** Players use an on-screen crosshair to choose a target within a minimal timeframe. Once time expires, all targets reveal their covert multipliers, and the gamer receives the multiplier corresponding to their selected spot.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the conventional Japanese arcade game, the Pachinko benefit includes a big physical wall filled with pegs.

- **The Mechanic:** The live host drops a puck from the top of the board. The puck bounces arbitrarily through the pegs until it settles at the bottom in among several landing zones, each including a multiplier.
- **The Special Rule:** If the puck lands in a zone marked "**DOUBLE**," all multipliers at the bottom of the board double in worth, and the host drops the puck a 2nd time. This can duplicate until the maximum payout cap is reached.

4. Crazy Time

The namesake bonus offer round occurs behind a red door, leading players into a fantastical, augmented-reality virtual world.

- **The Mechanic:** Inside this virtual area stands a massive wheel with 64 segments and 3 flappers (green, blue, and yellow).
