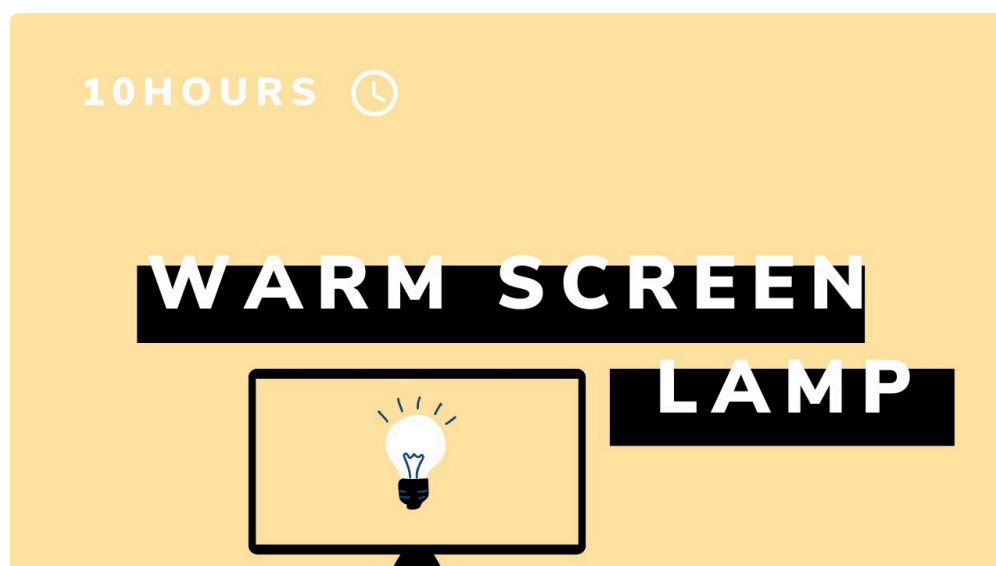
A strong installer will certainly talk pleasantly regarding these details. A weak one will certainly maintain steering the conversation back to shade effects.
