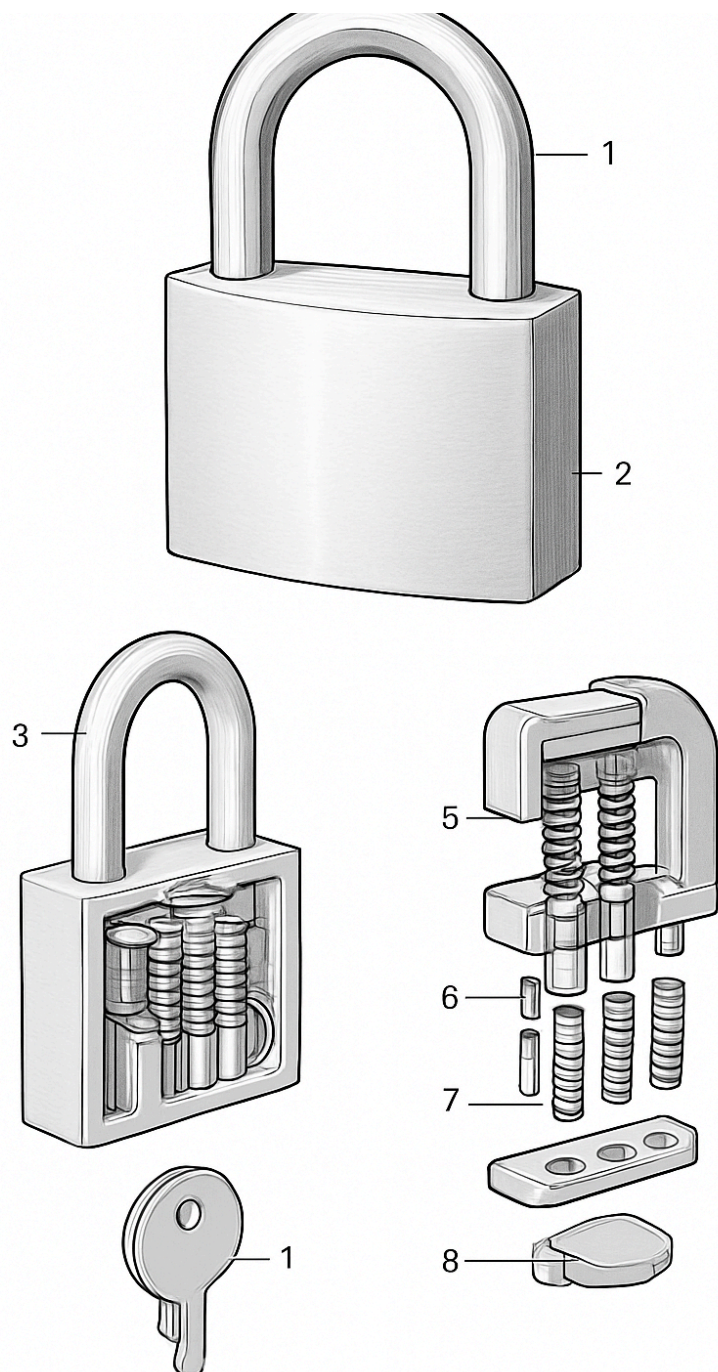
How a locksmith near me request turns into on-site help
