Yet it's actually a product of **OpenAI**, a complex organization with multiple facets: OpenAI LP, OpenAI Group PBC, and the OpenAI Foundation. To truly understand who "owns" ChatGPT, you need to look past headlines and press releases. Instead, think about ownership across four key dimensions: operator, legal structure, economic stakeholders, and governance control.

## 1. Operator

The **operator** is the entity that builds, runs, and maintains ChatGPT on a day-to-day basis.

- This is **OpenAI LP**, which develops ChatGPT's AI models, manages infrastructure, and provides the API and user interfaces.
- Users of ChatGPT agree to OpenAI's Terms of Use. For users in the European Union, the *European terms of use* apply, whereas other users follow the *rest-of-world terms*.
- The Terms of Use establish OpenAI LP as the service operator responsible for handling data, privacy, liability, and service levels.

So, practically speaking, the operator is who you interact with when you use ChatGPT.

## 2. Legal Structure

Ownership also relates to the **legal structure** — the shape and type of entity or entities that govern the product.

## 3. Economic Stakeholders

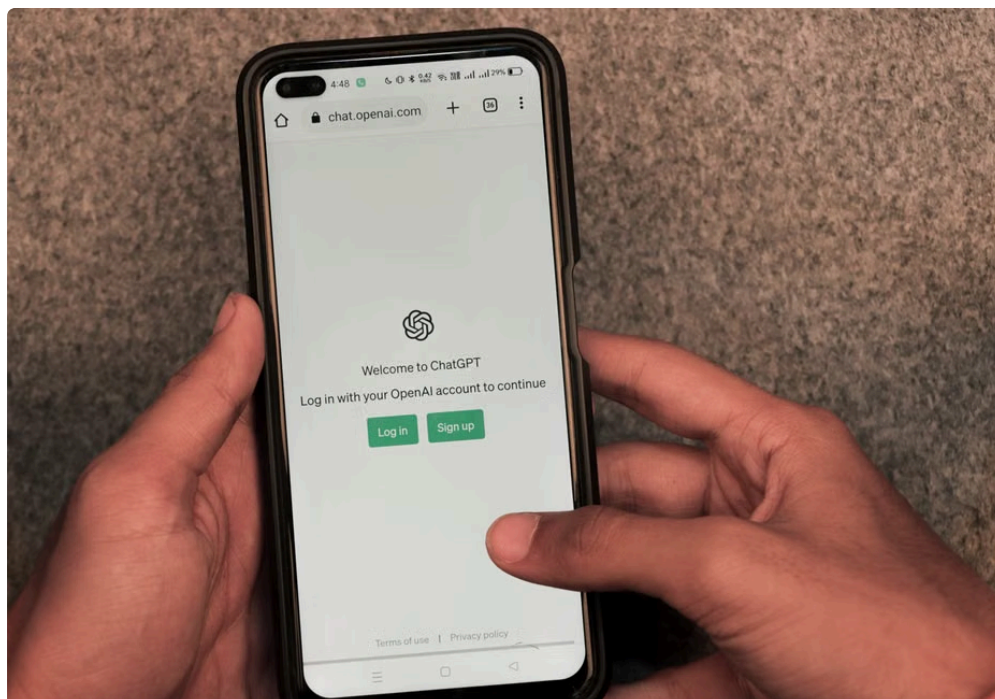
When discussing “ownership” most people mean **economic ownership**: who holds equity or financial interest in the company or product.

So while investors own stakes that could translate into financial gains, their rights and potential returns are capped and subject to special terms set within OpenAI's governing documents.

## 4. Governance Control

The final dimension — and perhaps the most distinctive — is **governance control**. This refers to who has the legal and practical power to steer OpenAI's mission, strategic priorities, and board decisions.



- The **OpenAI Foundation**, a nonprofit entity, holds special governance rights that effectively control OpenAI Group PBC and, by extension, OpenAI LP.
- This foundation appoints board members, sets overarching mission parameters, and keeps a public benefit focus central.
- This governance model ensures that, regardless of financial stakes or operational management, decisions promote responsible AI development aligned with societal good.
- In contrast to traditional startups, this control mechanism prevents outside investors or operators from overriding ethical considerations.

Thus, governance control differs significantly from both economic stakeholding and operational responsibilities.

## How These Dimensions Interact — A Summary

To summarize how these four dimensions interplay:

1. **Operator:** OpenAI LP runs and delivers ChatGPT every day.
2. **Legal structure:** The layered entities (OpenAI Group PBC, OpenAI LP, OpenAI Foundation) create a hybrid mission-driven organization.
3. **Economic stakeholders:** Investors and employees hold capped financial interests in OpenAI LP, which are limited in upside.
