Stick strictly to main Valve drop systems and the main Steam Community Market to keep accounts completely safe.

1. Do I require CS: GO/CS2 Prime Status to get free cases?

Yes. To be qualified for weekly case drops and item drops, your Steam account should have Prime Status. Non-prime accounts do not receive random item drops or profile XP benefits that set off the weekly care bundle.
