What is Crazy Time?

At its core, Crazy Time is a live dealership game constructed around a massive, vertically mounted 54-segment wheel. Hosted by an energetic, live presenter in a dynamic, Willy Wonka-esque studio, the video game streams in real-time to gamers around the world.

Unlike standard table video games like blackjack or live roulette, Crazy Time needs no complex memorization of rules or strategy charts. Gamers just put bets on where they believe the wheel will stop, making it available to outright novices while still using the high volatility and massive win capacity that experienced bettors yearn for.

How the Game is Played

Every video game round begins with a betting phase. Gamers have a minimal time to place their chips on several of the 8 readily available betting alternatives on the virtual layout. These choices consist of four numbers (1, 2, 5, and 10) and four distinct bonus games.

As soon as wagering closes, the live host spins the giant wheel. All at once, a separate two-reel slot placed above the primary wheel-- known as the **Top Slot**-- spins along with it.

The Top Slot Mechanism

Before the wheel stops, the Top Slot generates a random multiplier and appoints it to one of the 8 wagering alternatives on the wheel.

- If the Top Slot multiplier and the wheel result line up on the same sector, the multiplier uses to that win.
- If the result is a bonus offer video game, the multiplier boosts all the multipliers *inside* that specific benefit round, causing potentially astronomical payments.

Understanding the Wheel Segments and Payouts

The 54 sectors on the Crazy Time wheel are distributed amongst numbers and bonus offer games. Naturally, the lower-paying numbers appear far more frequently on the wheel than the rare reward rounds.

Breakdown of Wheel Segments

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times (Payout: 1:1)
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times (Payout: 2:1)
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times (Payout: 5:1)
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times (Payout: 10:1)
- **Coin Flip Bonus:** Appears 4 times
- **Cash Hunt Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Pachinko Bonus:** Appears 2 times
- **Crazy Time Bonus:** Appears 1 time

Dive Into the Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The real magic-- and the source of the video game's most significant payouts-- lies within its four interactive benefit rounds. Whenever the wheel arrive on a benefit sector, players who positioned a bet on that particular feature are carried to a secondary video game screen.

1. Coin Flip

The simplest of the four perks, this round features a coin with a red side and a blue side.

- Each side is designated a random multiplier before the flip.
- The host presses a button to turn the coin, and whichever color lands face-up awards the corresponding multiplier to the player's bet.

2. Money Hunt

This is a huge interactive shooting gallery including a screen with 108 random multipliers concealed behind numerous symbols (like a cactus, target, or chef's hat).

- Players utilize a virtual crosshair to aim and shoot at a sign of their option before a countdown timer ends.
- When time runs out, all symbols expose their hidden multipliers, and the player wins whatever worth they shot.

3. Pachinko

Influenced by the traditional Japanese arcade game, Pachinko features a large wall filled with physical pegs.

- The host drops a puck from the top of the board.
- The puck bounces randomly down the pegs until it lands in among the slots at the bottom, which includes a multiplier.
- If the puck lands in a "**DOUBLE**" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for an even bigger payment.

4. Crazy Time

The crown gem of the video game. When **Bitz** set off, the host opens a red door leading into a surreal, brightly colored virtual world featuring an enormous, 64-segment mega-wheel.

- Players need to select among three flappers: **Green, Blue, or Yellow**.
- The host spins the wheel, and the flapper the gamer chosen determines their prize.
- This wheel features "**DOUBLE**" and "**TRIPLE**" sections. If the flapper indicate among these, all multipliers on the wheel multiply, and the wheel spins again-- allowing wins to scale approximately the video game's optimum cap of 500,000 x!

Techniques for Playing Crazy Time

While Crazy Time is eventually a video game of chance determined by RNG and physics, players frequently use different betting methods to handle their bankroll and maximize their time playing.



Popular Betting Approaches

- **The Safe/Conservative Strategy:** Betting heavily on the numbers (1 and 2) alongside a little cover bet on the benefit rounds. This technique yields regular, smaller wins, keeping the bankroll steady for longer periods.
- **The Bonus-Only Strategy:** Ignoring the numbers completely and placing little bets solely on the 4 reward rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, and Crazy Time). This method is high-risk, high-reward, as it depends on striking the relatively unusual bonus sections to see a return.
- **The Spread Strategy:** Placing bets across a wide range of sections (numbers and bonuses alike) to make sure that a high portion of the wheel yields some form of return.

Vital Tips for Beginners

- **Set a Budget:** Decide on a fixed entertainment budget plan before logging in and never ever chase losses.
- **Understand Volatility:** Bonus rounds do not hit on every spin. Anticipate dry spells while awaiting a bonus to activate.
- **Play for Entertainment:** Remember that live gambling establishment video games are created mainly for enjoyable and entertainment, not as a reliable source of income.
