In Philadelphia, I have seen more flooded basements at 2 a.m. Than at any reasonable hour of the workday. Old real estate stock, narrow rowhomes, shared sewer lines, and winter season temperature level swings all make plumbing here a little more unforgiving than in lots of other cities.
