

Drum damage in a washing machine is not just a repair cost question—it is a safety decision. Before any cost discussion, you must shut off the machine immediately and verify whether water is reaching the base or back panel. If you see standing water, corrosion, or moisture near the motor, the hazard is active, and the machine must not run until a licensed technician inspects it. This is different from a single-point repair. A drum replacement typically costs \$300 to \$500 in parts and labor for a standard front-load or top-load unit, depending on the brand and model. However, the yes-or-no decision is not cost—it is whether the machine can operate safely again at all. Homes in East Sacramento and Land Park that we serve often ask whether patching a crack buys time. It does not. A patched drum will continue to leak, and water will continue to migrate toward electrical hazards. Is Water Pooling in the Machine's Base a Reason to Shut Down Now?

One of the clearest stop signals is visible water accumulating in the base of the washer during or immediately after a cycle. This indicates the drum seal has failed or the drum itself is compromised. Do not run another cycle. Shut off the machine at the breaker if you suspect active leaking. Water in the base creates conditions for mold growth, electrical component corrosion, and in worst cases, shock hazards if someone touches metal parts while the machine is plugged in. Residents near Sacramento Metro Fire District Station 62 and Station 101 know that fire and electrical hazards are taken seriously in our community, and we treat drum-related water leaks the same way.
