Brittle tabs on older three-tab roofs tell me hail and UV have taken a toll, although the roof appears to be like intact from the road. At valleys close dormers or at chimney saddles, I cost the flashing gauge and the step flashing spacing, seeing that many older installations used shorter pieces that lift in wind.

I look at drip aspect coverage, the gap among shingles and fascia, and the downspout discharge.
