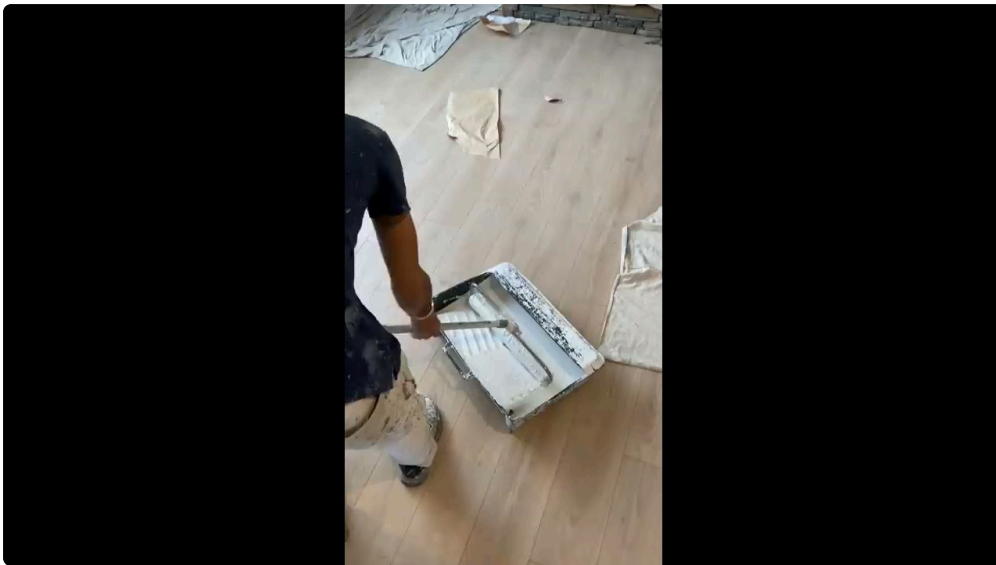

We again-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic on the physique and used a moderately minimize sheen on the crown data to hold glare down less than the afternoon sunlight.

The homeowner told me later that the fabulous funds spent used to be no longer the paint company however the time budgeted for caulking and spot-priming at elevation.
