On evening two, we tackled revenues flooring shelving and the closing mixed debris. Each keep ran about 90 cubic yards entire, or six vans, with 65 to 70 percent diversion. Cardboard bales accounted for two vehicles worthy of amount we did now not should haul, which reduce disposal expenditures via around 20 %. E-waste went to a certified recycler with a serialized record, and we added photograph packets to the district manager before 7 a.m. Final stroll-throughs with the owner went easily. The largest time saver was a manager who staged broken products and often called out two furnishings that had been shifting to a nearby place so we did now not by accident haul them.

Aftercare: ending sparkling and remaining the loop
