Asian fusion restaurants blend techniques and ingredients from various culinary traditions. These restaurants may be especially appealing for diners seeking original small plates, vegan options, or a more unconventional menu. If you have gluten-free options or other dietary restrictions, ask about sauces, marinades, shared fryers, and cross-contact before ordering.

Italian, Mediterranean, and European Dining
