The notification needs to be offered on all adjacent proprietors, both estate and leasehold, and owners can be recognized by means of an examination on the online land computer registry. As soon as you serve notice on your neighbors about doing job that impacts a party wall surface, they will certainly have the possibility to consider your notification and express their problems, if they have any kind of. If your neighbors don't agree with your plans, you need to have a Party Wall surface arrangement created. You should serve an Area 2 notification a minimum of 2 months before beginning job.
