- **Case price:** varies, frequently between £ 0.50 and £ 3.00 on the marketplace.
- **Secret rate:** repaired at £ 2.50 (GBP) from the in-game shop.

- **Usage two-factor authentication:** Protect your Steam account with Steam Guard to prevent unauthorized access to your stock and market transactions.
