Building a straight, feathered boundary that resists peeling and remains genuine using seasonal stream is the mark of a disciplined crew.

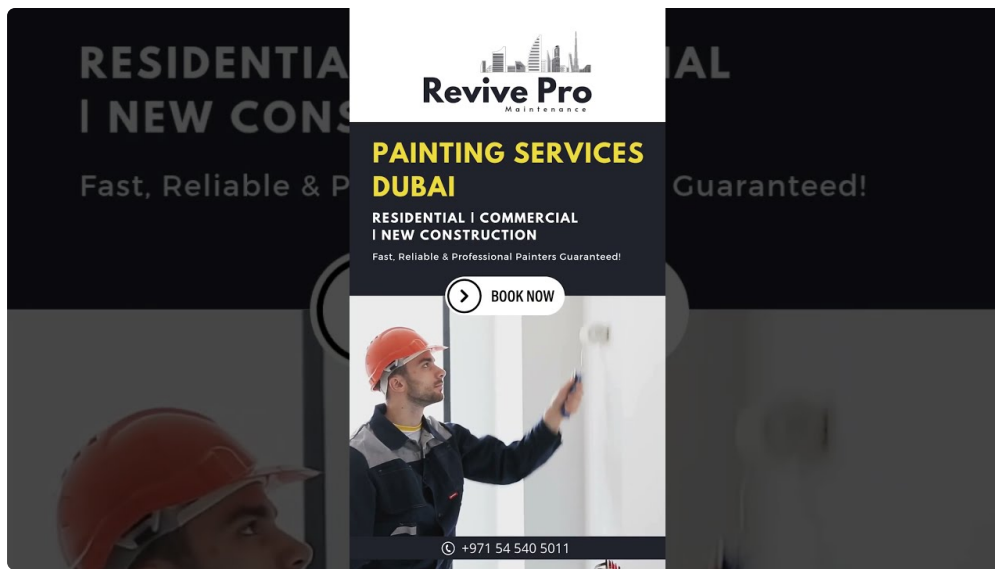
