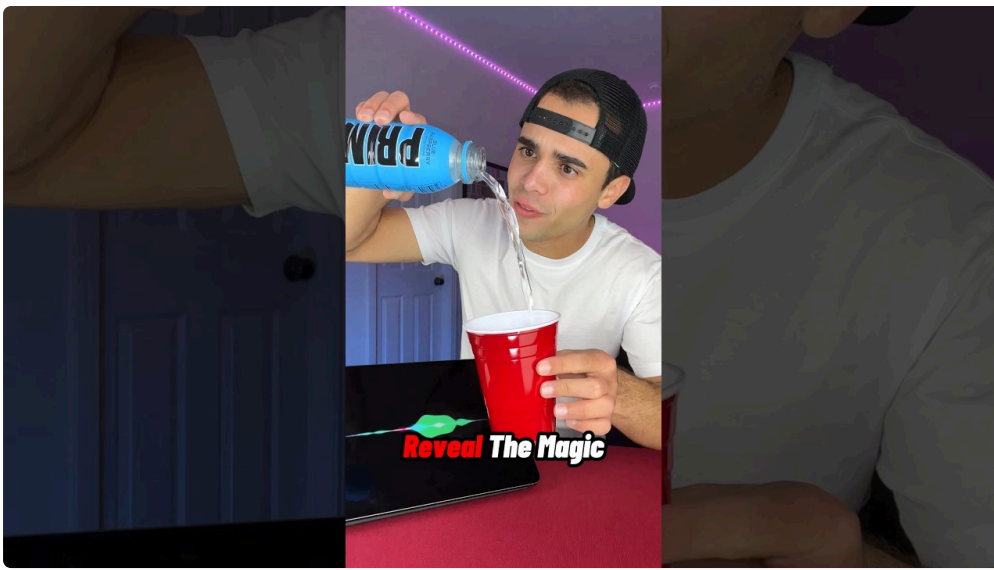

Before you birth practising, take two mins to set your self up. Most shuffling considerations come from grip, deck situation, and friction.

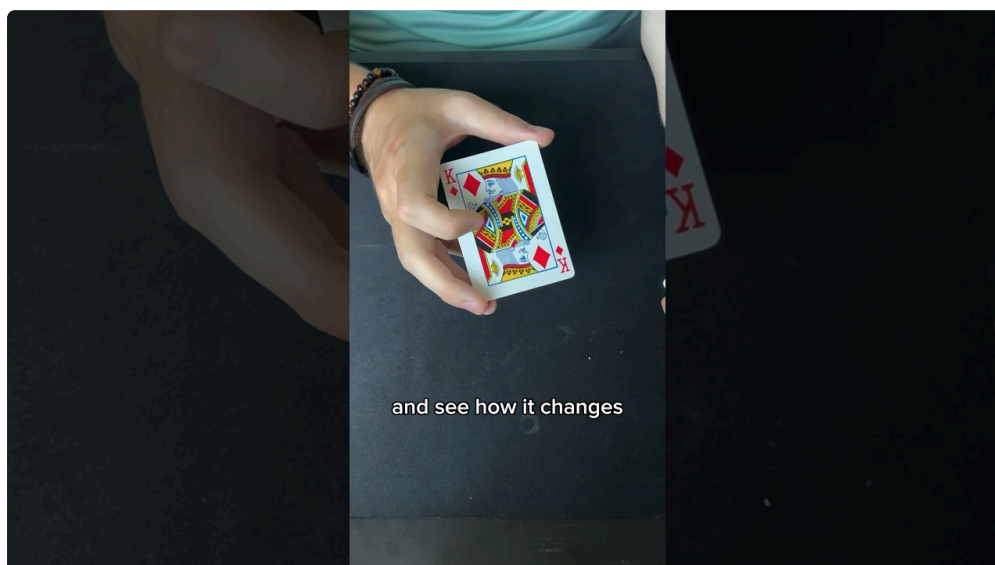

- 10 minutes: rfile one effort on video, then watch from the spectator perspective.

This closing section is the place growth jumps. Your palms will deceive you. A camera doesn't.

The maximum natural newbie mistake is "I practiced a great deal, so it may still work." Often, it really works for your head however not within the viewer's eyes.

A small, risk-free trick you can still practice fast: ideal-card regulate with an overhand shuffle
