## Step-by-Step Troubleshooting Checklist

### 1. Confirm Game Integrity through Steam

- Browse to the **Installed Files** tab.

### 2. Handle Launch Options

### 4. Adjust In-Game Video Settings

- Set **Global Shadow Quality** to Medium or Low.
- Disable **Ambient Occlusion** and **High Dynamic Range (Quality)**.
- Limit optimum frame rates (fps\_max 0 can sometimes trigger excessive coil whine and GPU stress; capping frames to match display refresh rates or a stable threshold is frequently more secure).

## The Role of Hardware Stability in Source 2
