Note: The precise probability for a particular knife (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a fraction of the rare special item pool.

These numbers show that the overwhelming bulk of openings will produce basic skins, not knives. The low possibility makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.

- **Understand the Odds**-- Recognize that the huge bulk of openings will not yield a knife. The anticipated return is negative.
- **Prevent Chasing Losses**-- If a gamer invests a fixed budget plan without obtaining a knife, it is suggested to stop instead of effort to "recover" losses.
