4. Jackpot

In a Jackpot game, multiple players throw skins into a main pot. Each skin adds to the player's general portion opportunity of winning the entire pot (based upon the dollar value of their contribution). A virtual spinner selects a winning ticket, and one fortunate player takes home all the transferred skins.
