Homeowners may need to organize packing, furniture, storage, utility transfers, family schedules, and property access. Businesses may need to move workstations, technology, inventory, records, equipment, and employees while keeping operations running.

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Build a Complete Moving Checklist

Start preparing as soon as you know you will be moving. Create a checklist that includes requesting moving estimates, decluttering, purchasing packing supplies, transferring utilities, changing your address, updating insurance, arranging internet service, reserving elevators, confirming parking, and preparing the new location.

For a residential move, create a room-by-room inventory that includes furniture, appliances, boxes, electronics, artwork, fragile belongings, outdoor items, and storage contents. For a business move, list workstations, desks, chairs, computers, monitors, printers, phones, filing cabinets, records, supplies, inventory, and specialized equipment.

An accurate inventory helps moving companies prepare more detailed estimates. It also helps you decide what to move, sell, donate, recycle, discard, or place into storage before moving day.

Residential Moving Services

Residential moving services may support apartments, townhomes, condominiums, single-family homes, senior transitions, and multi-family properties. Basic moving often includes loading, transportation, and unloading.

Full-service moving may include packing, unpacking, moving supplies, furniture blankets, protective wrapping, disassembly, reassembly, storage, and specialty-item handling. Choose a service level based on your budget, timeline, packing ability, and the complexity of the move.

Interstate moving companies and brokers must be registered with the federal government and have a U.S. Department of Transportation number. Consumers can use FMCSA tools to check registration, insurance, authority to transport household goods, and complaint information. [335]

Keep Important Documents Together

Keep all moving documents in a secure folder. Your records should include written estimates, order-for-service documents, inventories, bills of lading, valuation forms, storage agreements, payment receipts, emails, and messages with the moving company.

The bill of lading is an important transportation agreement. Review it carefully before signing and make sure the pickup address, delivery address, services, inventory, valuation coverage, and charges match your understanding.

For business relocations, create separate procedures for confidential records, employee files, customer data, financial information, passwords, computers, backup drives, and other sensitive materials. Keep essential data and documents under the control of authorized staff.

Protect Important Belongings

For residential moves, keep medications, passports, keys, identification, financial records, jewelry, laptops, chargers, work documents, and immediate essentials with you. Do not place these items on a moving truck.

For commercial moves, protect confidential files, client records, technology, employee information, financial documents, data backups, and items that require specialized handling. Label equipment clearly and create an inventory before the move begins.



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Take photographs of high-value and fragile belongings. Ask the mover to explain valuation coverage, claims procedures, coverage limits, exclusions, and the steps required if an item is lost or damaged.

Plan Parking and Property Access

Parking and building access can affect the time and cost of a move. If the truck must park far from the property, movers may spend more time carrying belongings. Stairs, elevators, narrow hallways, loading docks, restricted access, and long walkways can also affect the schedule.



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Contact your landlord, property manager, homeowners association, condominium board, or building supervisor before moving day. Confirm parking permits, loading zones, elevator reservations, gate codes, moving hours, and insurance requirements.

For business moves, coordinate loading docks, security check-in, freight elevator use, employee access, parking, and building procedures with property management well before the scheduled relocation date.
