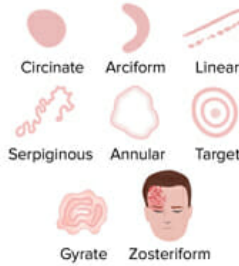

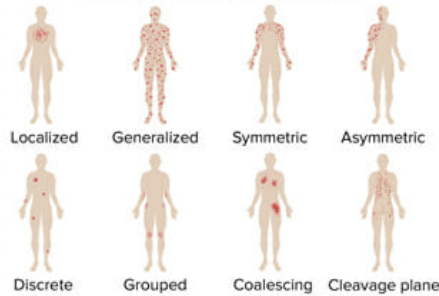
Assessment/ documentation of skin lesions should include:
