

Brush piles can grow quickly after trimming, lot cleanup, fence-line work, and storm recovery. Small piles may be manageable with routine yard-waste service, but larger piles often contain long limbs, heavy branches, and bulky material that is difficult to cut and load by hand.

When a Grapple Truck Is the Better Option

A grapple truck is useful when the pile is too large for regular pickup, contains heavy tree sections, or must be removed quickly. The loader can reach, lift, and place bulky debris into the truck body without requiring extensive hand loading.

How to Place the Pile

Place brush where the truck can access it safely. Keep the pile away from overhead utilities, mailboxes, fences, parked vehicles, drainage structures, and low tree limbs. Do not mix tree debris with household trash, roofing, metal, concrete, or chemicals.
