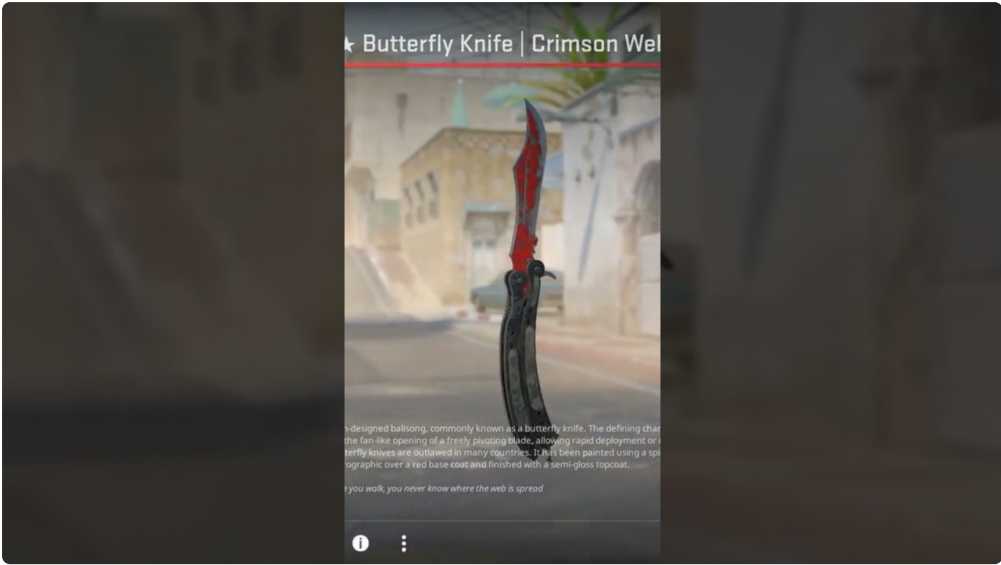


Cheap CS: GO Cases: A Comprehensive Guide for Budget-Conscious Players
