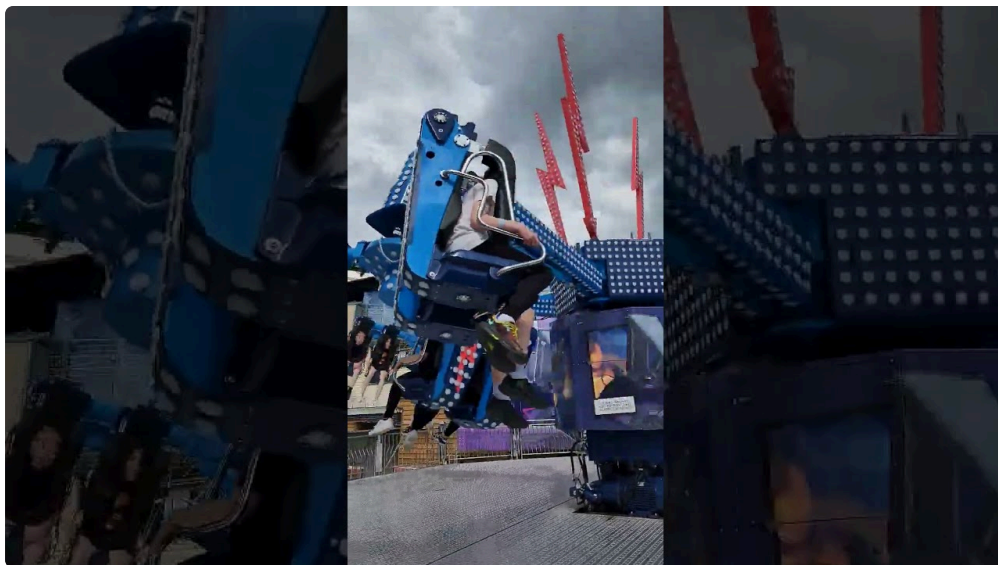
1. Visual layout generator that exports to Figma or HTML, used for immediate mockups and iteration.

3. Writing assistant that produces diverse CTA and hero textual content variants, plus meta descriptions.
4. Accessibility auditor that assessments contrast, ARIA roles, and keyboard concentrate order.
5. Design token extractor that turns your UI record right into a reusable genre manual and CSS variables.
