LAX is conveniently located just minutes from Santa Monica and the beaches are only a half-hour trip, traffic-permitting, from Hollywood and the Westside. Recognizing these patterns and making use of the right tools can make a substantial difference in your traveling time and overall experience navigating LA's highways. The Los Angeles Metro Rail system links areas across the county, consisting of Long Coastline, Pasadena, Norwalk, El Segundo, North Hollywood, Inglewood and Midtown Los Angeles. The network consists of 4 above-ground public transportation lines (the A, C, E, and K lines) and one below ground metro with 2 branches (the B and D lines). In between its public transportation and heavy rail systems, Metro Rail has 107.4 miles (172.8 kilometres) of rail, averaging 308,653 trips per weekday, and accountancy for approximately 1.1% of the 29 million day-to-day trips originating in Los Angeles County. The J Line runs 38 miles (61 km) along Interstate 10 and Interstate 110 between El Monte and midtown San Pedro. Consisting of other municipal bus drivers, Los Angeles Area averages 1.7 million bus boardings per weekday, accounting for approximately 5.9% of the 29 million day-to-day journeys originating in Los Angeles County.
