- **Play Regularly Throughout the Week:** Don't cram all your playtime into one day. The XP required for subsequent drops increases slightly, making a constant rate more efficient.
- **Watch on the Active Drop Pool:** When Valve updates the active case pool, older cases relocate to the unusual drop swimming pool and frequently appreciate in value over time. Keeping dropped cases can be a smart financial move.
