Armor + utility, or high-tier handguns (P250/Deagle) without armor. **Eco Round** A saving round where the group spends little to no cash. Base handguns, perhaps a couple of flashbangs, conserving for the next round. **Force Buy** Purchasing weapons despite a low bank to capture the opponent off guard. SMGs (MP9/Mac

-10), Deagles, or Scout with no/light armor. **Complete Buy** Optimum monetary health. Buying the best rifles and full energy. Rifles (AK-47/ M4A4), complete armor/helmet, complete utility, and a Defuse Kit (CT).

## Key Tactical Elements in CS2

To win contemporary CS2 video game battles, gamers need to master a number of foundational mechanics that separate casual players from elite competitors.

### 1. The New Smoke Meta

CS2 introduced volumetric, dynamic smoke grenades that connect with the environment. Bullets and high-explosive (HE) grenades can momentarily clear sightlines through smoke. Players need to adapt their execution designs:

- Use HE grenades tactically to clear sniper angles in smokes.

- **Master the Recoil Patterns:** Spend time in deathmatch servers finding out spray patterns for the AK-47, M4A1-S, and Galil/Famas.
