

A properly operating garage door safeguards your vehicle, belongings, and home while allowing easy daily access. - **Spring repair or replacement:** Springs counterbalance the weight of the door. A broken spring can make the door extremely heavy or cause the door will not open.
- **Garage door panel repair:** A dented, cracked, or warped garage door panel may sometimes be fixed, although replacement is often more reasonable when the panel is severely damaged.
