3. Low Auto-Cashout Grinding

- **How it works:** Players set an automatic cashout at a very low multiplier, such as **1.10 x to 1.20 x**, and place bigger bets.
- **The Risk:** While winning percentage is high, an instantaneous 1.00 x crash will eliminate multiple wins in a single blow.
