Sometimes the moving date and the new property's availability do not perfectly align. Temporary storage may therefore become part of the relocation plan.

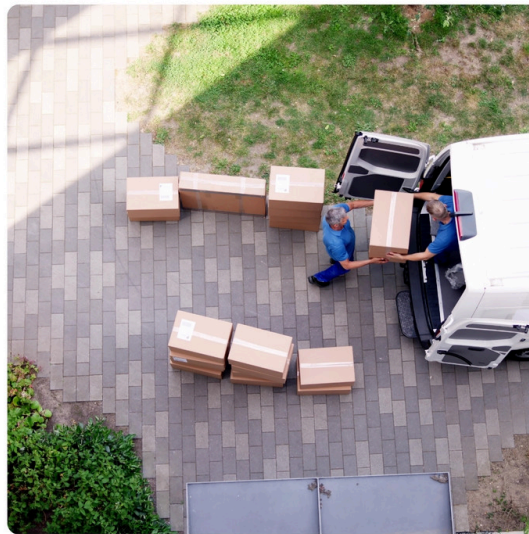
