1) It need to use props you can control devoid of fumbling

2) It need to allow a clean second of pause earlier than the change three) It should always give you a reason why to move your arms the way the manner requires

There are multiple industrial or DIY approaches to try this, adding gimmicked units bought especially for color modifications. If you favor a gimmicked choice, ascertain it's one thing you'll be able to reset swiftly, and that the gimmick does now not require you to address it like a laboratory system.

## Hand positions that maintain the key from leaking

Regardless of technique, there are a couple of hand conduct that maintain your result.

- Keep your "paintings hand" in the direction of the frame than you suspect you should still in the beginning. That doesn't imply hiding it utterly. It method lowering how a great deal surface environment the target market can experiment for suspicious stream.
