We scrape to a organization part, feather with 80 to a hundred and twenty grit, then spot top naked places with an oil or alkyd bonding primer that blocks tannin bleed, mainly on cedar and redwood. Over sound paint, an acrylic primer-surfacer levels minor checking and lays a uniform base. If the home has lead paint, we shift to EPA RRP lead-safe practices, which means that containment, HEPA extraction, and genuine refreshing down tactics.
