## **4. Keeping Guests Fueled**

So they can sing their hearts out. For food, go with easy-to-eat finger foods. Where guests bring a dish to share. For drinks, have plenty of water. For guests who don't drink alcohol. A karaoke party can get chaotic. So guests can reserve their spot. Limit each guest to one or two songs. This can be you or a friend. And you don't waste time searching. Have a "group song" every 30 minutes. Take breaks between sets. Or have a backup plan. And having a backup microphone. Encourage guests who are shy. Where everyone feels comfortable



## 8. Capturing the Memories

A karaoke party is full of memorable moments. Or hire a photographer. Set up a photo booth. Especially the funny ones. Create a "highlight reel". So guests can share their photos on social media. Where guests can write their favorite karaoke memory. And have guests sign them. With everyone singing together. Make sure to get a photo of the birthday person. The goal is to capture the joy and the laughter

## 9. Etiquette and Inclusivity

To ensure a positive experience for all. Let them sing when they're ready. Everyone should get a turn. This creates a positive and encouraging atmosphere. Avoid offensive songs. Follow their rules. Without shouting. So guests who don't drink. So everyone can participate. Be inclusive. Where everyone feels comfortable
