Good prep on fences almost always consists of a soft wash, not a brutal blast. Pressure washing at 1,200 to 1,800 PSI with a 25 degree tip is an awful lot for so much timber and vinyl. Higher pressures can drive water into joints and raise the grain, that means greater sanding and an extended dry down.

For mould, treat with an answer well matched with the substrate. Sodium hypochlorite combined with water, plus a surfactant, handles healthy boom on timber and vinyl. Rinse completely. For steel, degreasers dispose of oils from hands and installs. Rinse and dry beforehand you ultimate.

Sanding feathers edges the place historical coatings continue to be. On wooden, a eighty to one hundred twenty grit move on difficult areas stages fibers raised by using washing and provides teeth to a better coat. On vinyl, scuff merely glossy locations. On steel, sanding focuses on edges and rust scars.
