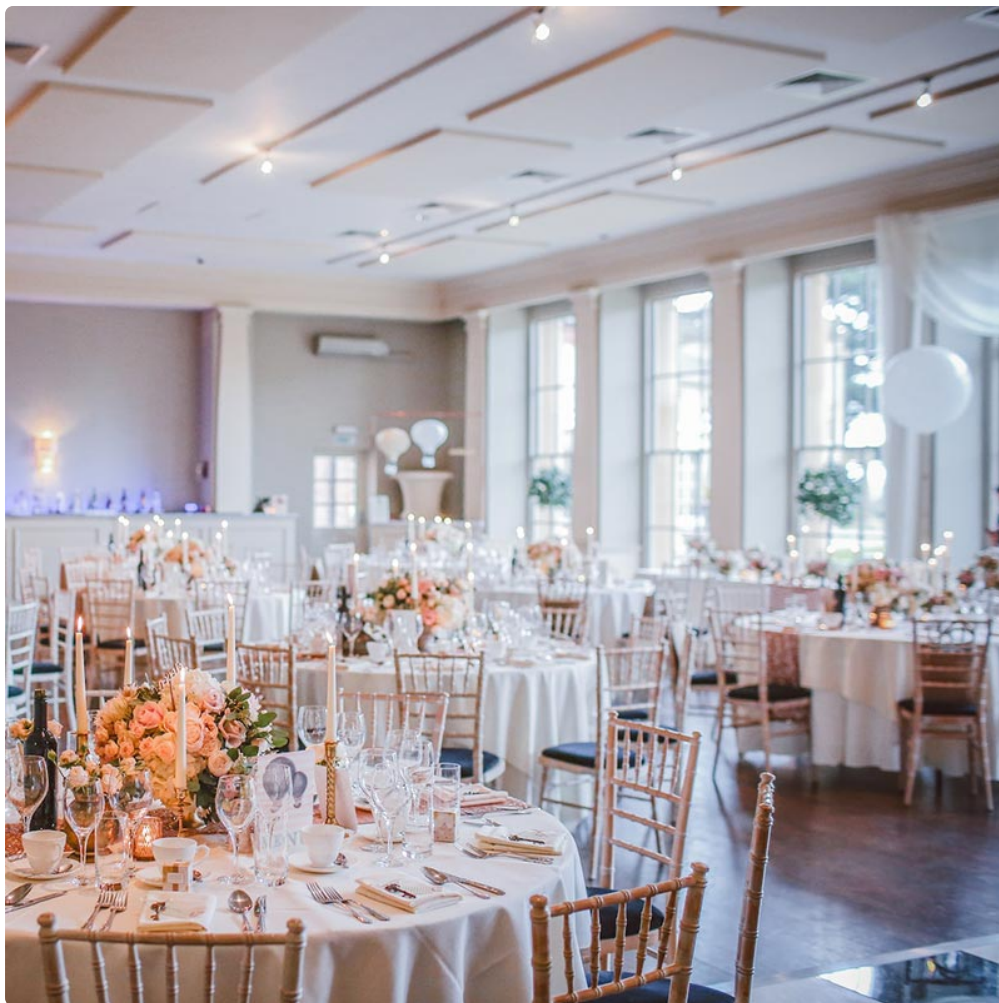
Kollysphere inspects the subsequent critical elements during a pre-event site survey.

The Physical Layout

The first and most essential element is the physical area itself. The team measures the exact dimensions of the expo space—length, breadth, and overhead clearance. We identify any pillars, columns, or obstructions that could affect booth placement. We verify the flooring surface and its weight-bearing capability, which is crucial for substantial exhibits. And we evaluate the accessibility of storage areas for empty crates and materials.

Beyond the Obvious

The subsequent vital component is the location's utilities and infrastructure. Kollysphere verifies the availability and position of electrical outlets, the voltage and current accessible, and whether extra electricity will need to be supplied. We also review the lighting, the ventilation, the water provision, and the online connectivity available at the location.



The Movement

The third crucial element is access and logistics. The team inspects the loading bays and assesses whether they can accommodate the dimensions of vehicles that will bring display items. We check the route from the loading area to the booth location, identifying any tight corners, slender doorways, or elevators that could pose challenges. How Site Surveys Prevent Costly Mistakes

One of the most common and costly mistakes is commissioning a display that does not fit the area. Without a site survey, exhibitors often count on the venue's published dimensions, which may be inexact or may not account for pillars, blockages, or irregular forms. A site survey ensures that the stand is created to fit the real space perfectly.

Preventing Power and Utility Issues|The Technical Problem|Beyond the Guess

Another frequent error is underestimating power requirements or assuming that the space has the necessary utilities. A site inspection pinpoints exactly what power is accessible, where it is located, and what supplementary infrastructure may need to be brought in. This prevents last-minute rushing and costly crisis rentals.

Preventing Logistics and Access Issues|The Movement Problem|Beyond the Delay

A third frequent error is omitting to plan for logistics and access. A site inspection pinpoints possible congestion points, access restrictions, and scheduling conflicts that could delay installation or damage supplies. With this information, the team can organize a fluid, efficient installation and move-out.
