What Causes My Garage Door Not to Open or Close?

If your garage door will not open, first check whether the opener has power and whether the remote control has a working battery. Wall buttons, circuit breakers, and the opener's emergency release can also affect operation. If the motor runs but the door does not move, the problem may involve the drive gear, trolley, spring, or garage door cable.

If the garage door will not close, inspect the photo-eye sensors near the floor on both sides of the opening. These photo-eye sensors must face one another and remain free of dust, objects, or misalignment. Blinking lights often indicate that the sensors are not functioning as they should. Do not bypass this safety feature.

A bent or obstructed garage door track can also prevent smooth movement. A technician can check track alignment, rollers, brackets, spring tension, and opener settings. If the door is heavy or drops quickly when disconnected from the opener, stop testing it and arrange professional garage door repair.

What Can a Grinding or Squeaking Garage Door Indicate?

Squeaking, popping, or scraping usually indicates that one or several moving parts need cleaning, adjusting, lubrication, or replacement. Worn garage door rollers can rub against the track, while dry garage door hinges may creak as each section flexes during travel. Loose hardware can create shaking or vibration.

Basic lubrication is part of garage door maintenance, but the correct product and application are important. A technician can lubricate compatible hinges, bearings, rollers, and springs while inspecting for wear. Avoid applying heavy grease to the track because it can collect dirt and interfere with roller movement.

A garage door tune-up may include tightening hardware, checking balance, inspecting cables, testing safety reversal, and assessing the opener. Because springs and cables are under significant tension, homeowners should not try to adjust or remove them.
