2. Energy Synergy

Throwing energy randomly wastes valuable resources. Reliable teams coordinate their utility to attain particular goals:

- **Flashbangs:** Pop-flashes that detonate instantly in the enemy's field of vision, rejecting them a possibility to look away.
- **Molotovs/Incendiaries:** Used to clear tight angles (like "Newell" on Inferno or "Banana") and hold-up opponent presses.
- **Smokes:** Block sniper lanes and isolate bomb websites throughout execution.

3. Map Control and Defaulting
