Understanding the Top Slot and Multipliers

Before every spin of the main wheel, a smaller sized two-reel fruit machine situated straight above the wheel-- understood as the **Top Slot**-- spins simultaneously.

- **How it works:** The Top Slot creates one random wheel section (a number or a reward game) and sets it with a random multiplier ranging from 2x to 50x.
- **The Result:** If the primary wheel arrive on the exact segment displayed in the Top Slot, the multiplier is applied to that spin. If it is a number bet, the payout is increased. If it is a benefit game, the multipliers within the perk round are increased appropriately.

The Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The main attraction of the game is its 4 reward rounds. Gamers who have actually positioned a wager on the specific bonus section are granted entry into the mini-game when the wheel lands on it.

1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sectors on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** An easy red and blue coin is flipped by a machine. Before the flip, each side of the coin is appointed a random multiplier. Whichever color lands face up figures out the gamer's payment.

2. Money Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** The screen shows an enormous board including 108 random multipliers hidden behind shooting gallery signs (like a duck, a cactus, or a target). Gamers are provided a limited time to goal and fire a cannon at a sign of their choice to reveal their multiplier.

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** A radiant puck is dropped from the top of an enormous Pachinko wall filled with pegs. The puck bounces down arbitrarily up until it lands in one of the slots at the bottom, each containing a multiplier. If the puck arrive at a "DOUBLE," all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** Only 1 sector on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** Players step behind a red door into a vibrant, surreal virtual world including an enormous 64-segment wheel. The host chooses among 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper indicate is awarded. Like Pachinko, this wheel includes "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" sectors, enabling multipliers to rise to a shocking 20,000 x.

- **Focus On the Bonus Rounds:** Statistically, the home edge on the number sections (1, 2, 5, 10) is generally higher than the perk rounds. Lots of seasoned gamers choose to position small bets solely on the four bonus sectors to chase the video game's optimum payout potential.
- **Set a Strict Budget:** The fast-paced nature of live game programs can lead to fast costs. Pick a set bankroll before you begin playing and adhere to it, despite wins or losses.
- **Do Not Chase Losses:** If you experience a cold streak where the wheel bypasses your bets, prevent the temptation to increase your stake sizes to recover lost funds rapidly.
