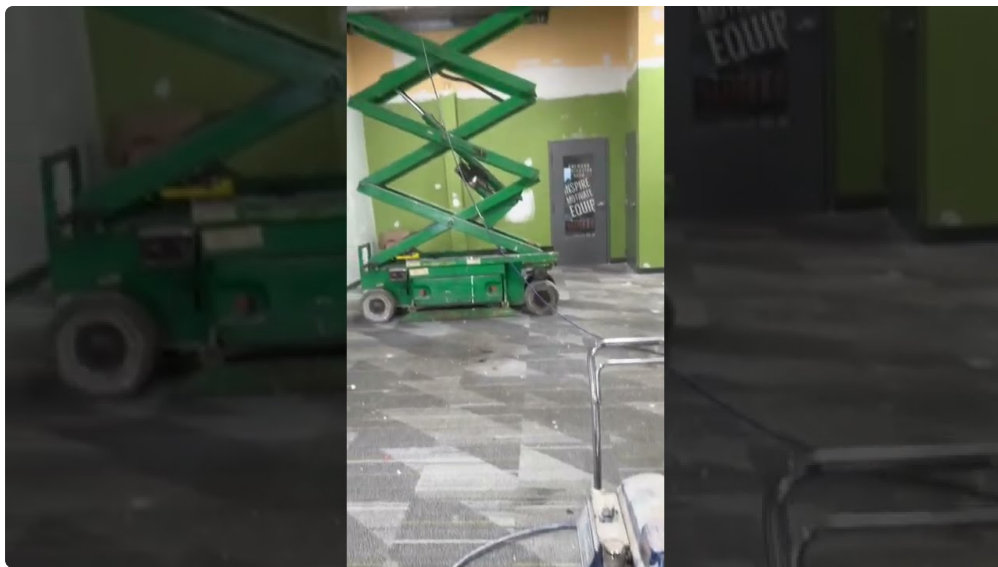

Temperature, dew level, and wind velocity all effect a paint film.
