

No one remembers which Saturday I found out the change among a smartly-run network cleanup and one that limps along. I simply recall the smell of rainy leaves, a handful of volunteers standing round waiting for route, and a roll off dumpster arriving 40 minutes late to a dead-quit avenue that a 20-foot truck couldn't really exit. We still stuffed it, however we wasted half of the morning wrangling logistics. Since then I've helped towns, area institutions, and institution booster golf equipment plan dozens of cleanups. No overflow, no indignant emails, and a chuffed hauler who talked about, "You run a good web site."

Where to begin if it really is your first cleanup

If you're gazing a calendar and an enthusiastic organization chat, start with 3 cell calls. Call your town's public works office to recognise lets in and street use policies.
